WHAT DELAYS CANADIAN NAVAL CONSTRUCTION.

Sometimes home news comes to us from abroad, which news is also sometimes true, but by no means always so. Just now the New York Herald has tidings that the British Admiralty is delaying the construction of the Canadian navy and that Hon. Mr. Brodeur is "by no means satisfied" in that regard.

val construction plans are secret, as are the plans of all nations that build ships. The danger of leakage, of discovery or theft of the plans would be increased if the plans were distributed to Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

The Minister wants to call for tenders, let contracts, have keels laid down and to see the bustle of industry in our naval yards that are to be and hear the sound of hammers in the work of construction. He is held up, handicapped, irritated in fact, by the unwillingness of the British Admiralty to forward to Ottawa the plans of the cruisers, destroyers and torpedo craft which he is so eager to build.

There is enough in it to supply editorial material for a week for all the valued political journals and some resounding political thunder from Mr. Borden in his Ontario campaign.

THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION IN MEXICO NEAR AT HAND.

Mexico, now a prosperous and progressive nation, is to enjoy the luxury of a presidential election on the 25th of June, instant. President Porfirio Diaz, now nearly eighty years of age, is ending his seventh term as head of the Republic and is again a candidate to succeed himself.

but the Presidency in his hands for this and other reasons has gradually merged into a mild despotism. Perhaps this is a necessity in a land in which before Diaz began his long reign revolutions were almost as frequent as earthquakes.

When he was first elected to the Presidency in 1877 the constitution made him ineligible to succeed himself. He therefore had his good friend Gen. Gonzalez elected for one term beginning in 1880, and secured a change in the constitution under which he was enabled to be re-elected as often as he could secure the popular favor.

There are two candidates other than Diaz for the Presidency. One is Francisco Madero, whose family are wealthy and powerful. Just now, however Madero is under the disability of being a state prisoner in Fort Monterey, the appointee of President Diaz holding the key to the prison. The other candidate is one Barron, who is just now a resident of New York. He is also, for the time, poor. When he was nominated some time ago he owned two flourishing newspapers in the city of Mexico.

Mexico owes much of her civil order, growth and progress to Diaz,
