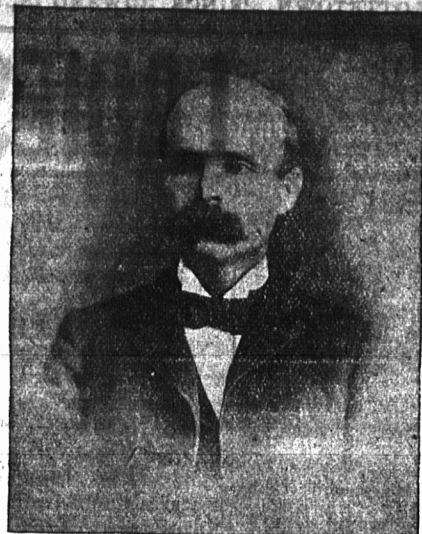

shareholders. The steamer cost \$20,000,
and is insured in the China Mutual and
another company of Halifax and in
English Lloyds for amounts aggregating
\$15,000.
