NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE WOMEN OF CANADA.

The arrangements for the annual meetings of the National Council of Women of Canada, which will be held in Toronto from May 20th to 27th inclusive are being completed, and everything points to one of the most interesting and successful meetings that have been held, and that is saying a great deal, as those who have attended the former meetings well know.

Through the kindness of the Government the meetings this year will be held in Victoria University, and that alone is a matter for congratulation, for the hall will be easy to speak in, and there will be plenty of space for committee rooms, lunch rooms, and the like, while the attractive surroundings and the beauty of the building itself will doubtless add to the pleasure of the visitors.

All the meetings with the exception of those of the Executive Committee, and of the Council on the last morning, will be open to the public and it is hoped the attendance will be very large. Each morning at 9.30 there will be a devotional meeting, arranged for by the King's Daughters, by request of the Council, as that organization is one of those in federation. The sessions will begin at 10 a.m., 2.30 p.m. and 8 p.m. each day, and the program will be of necessity so varied that almost every one will find something of special interest.

A reception will be held on the first evening, when the visitors will be the guests of the City Council, and of the Local Council of women, and thus an opportunity will be afforded of introducing the strangers to each other, and to the Toronto members. During the week several other social functions will be held in honor of the Council, and as time will permit an opportunity will be given the visitors to see something of the Charitable and other Institutions of the City.
