IN COMMEMORATION OF A HERO. BROCKVILLE, August 21—Court House square and surrounding points of vantage accommodated several thousand people this afternoon when Colonel the Hon. Sam Hughes, minister of militia, unveiled the handsome monument erected by the Brockville chapter of Daughters of the Empire, to commemorate the one hundredth anniversary of the death of General Sir Isaac Brock, the hero of the battle of Queenstown Heights. A great crowd surrounded the stand containing the speakers and invited guests, and as Colonel Hughes removed the large Union Jack covering the bronze bust of Brock, the band played "O Canada." Drawn up in line was a guard of honor from the 41st regiment and close by the Brockville Collegiate institute cadets, which the minister of militia inspected before entering upon the ceremonies. Colonel Hughes was presented with an address of welcome by Mayor MacLean and the minister was most happy in his reply showing at considerable length why the name of Brock has such a potent charm and tremendous influence in the life of Canadians today. "But our duty," he said, "is for each to become inspired with the same imperial spirit that characterized General Brock." He touched indirectly on the German peril by stating that England was facing a tremendous issue in Europe and that Canada, which heretofore had contributed nothing, had arrived at a stage when she was determined to bear a fair share in strengthening the British navy.

C. P. R. WINS POINT. (Canadian Press.) LONDON, Aug 22—The C. P. R. has won the first point in a ship officers strike and mount royal has sailed with strikers replaced. OFFICERS STRIKE. LONDON, Aug 21—A strike of ship's officers under the auspices of the Masters and Mates Union has broken out in consequence of which two C. P. R. boats the Mount Royal and Montreal, now lying in the port of London, are affected. The cause of the strike was the dismissal of Chief officer Keely of the C. P. R., owing to his refusal to perform dockers' duties during the recent dockers' strike. PROPELLOR BLADE OF OLYMPIC MISSING. LONDON, Aug. 21—The White Star Line Steamship Olympic, which left New York last Saturday with a blade of one of her propellers missing is expected to reach Plymouth late on Saturday next. The Olympic's passengers will be landed at Plymouth instead of at Southampton and the vessel will proceed to Belfast where her propeller will be repaired. A NEW AEROPLANE. BERLIN, Aug. 20—The Tagliche Rundschau says it learns that a German engineer made a remarkable invention, permitting an aeroplane to remain stationary in the air at a given point for an indefinite period. The form of aeroplane for which this amazing accomplishment is claimed is said to differ radically from any heavier-than-air machine hitherto constructed. The military authorities are said to be enthusiastic over the new invention, as it opens up incalculable possibilities in observation and the dropping of explosives. The Tagliche Rundschau says it would hesitate to circulate the announcement, which seems fantastic on its face, were the source of the information not unquestionable. GAMBLING CRAZE. PARIS, Aug. 21—The sensational suicide this week of Paul Michaelis, a Berlin lawyer, after the loss of his entire fortune at the Englien Casino just outside of Paris, has had as a consequence the drawing of public attention to the enormous growth of the gambling craze in France. Michaelis arrived at Englien at the end of last month with \$9,000 in cash. The day after his arrival he staked and lost the whole amount at the Casino. On the following evening \$600 raised on his jewelry went the same way. After writing a farewell letter to his wife, he quietly left the hotel and drowned himself in the Seine, the body being found two days afterwards by workmen walking along the banks. The exact amount raked in by the croupiers in gambling rooms during the season of 1911 was \$9,605,313. Of this sum more than two-thirds was yielded by various card games, coteils chebaux accounting for the rest.
