AN ENGLISH BISHOP HAS SWEET DREAM

Not of the Closing Night, But of the opening Dawn The Church of England's Future.

LONDON, October 8.—Dr. John William D'gle, Bishop of Carlisle, in opening the Church Congress at Barrow-in-Furness delivered a striking address on the subject of "The Present Opportunity of the Church of England." He said that the most solemn fact about the Church of England was that so small a proportion of the whole population and still smaller proportion of the male population attended her services. They condemned the indifference of the people; but their condemnation was unjust if they condoned the shortcomings in the Church. One of those shortcomings was that the world was too much in the Church and the Church too little in the world. They stood at the parting of the ways and the only choice was between reform and fresh development or decay and certain ruin.

"In my young days," concluded the Bishop "I often dreamed dreams, and now in my old age I sometimes see visions. Among my sweetest is that of a truly Catholic Apostolic Church, a Church as wide as the world, as holy as the glorious Gospel of the blessed God. In this vision I seem to see all the churches marching into the one fold of that one Church, with its one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one All-Father.

"In the van of the procession I see our own beloved Church of England, with a vast train of young and old, rich and poor, learned and ignorant, sinful yet pardoned, carried in her arms and holding on to her robes. Then I see the Nonconformist and

other Reformed Churches following close behind. Then the Greek and other Eastern churches, emancipated from their trammels and glowing with freedom. Then the Roman Church, purified as by fire, and last of all the hosts that no man can number, all washed in the blood of the Lamb. Then I awake and find it all a vision, yet not a vision of the black, closing night, but of the red, opening dawn."

CURZON'S MISTAKE DISTURBS BRITAIN

CALCUTTA, Oct. 8.—The coronation of a native King in Bengal probably means less as a menace to British rule than alarmists would make it appear. The coronation appears to have been a farce, with a sensation-loving native journalist as the chief character. Yet the situation has possibilities for mischief, and the Indian office is fully alive to them.

The native discontent arises from the late partition of the great Indian state. This was the chief mistake of Lord Curzon's career as viceroy. The province was overgrown and unwieldy, and was too large for a single lieutenant governor, but it could have been reduced to a manageable size without outraging the national sentiment of the Bengalis. The province has been for centuries an historical entity, it was the nucleus of the British empire in India, and the eastern half which is now looped off from the parent stem contains the most virile inhabitants, some of the richest districts, and some of the most historical remains of old Bengal.

To divide a people thus one in blood, language and history, by the arbitrary line of a river channel, was a mistake, and it is matter for regret that Mr. Morley elected to perpetuate Lord Curzon's mistake.

The Mohammedans are organizing a monster political combination, and have appealed to the viceroy to receive a great reputation which will voice the grievances and aspirations of their co-religionists. The viceroy has consented to receive the deputation, and the event is awaited with the greatest interest.

A news despatch reports that a secret society called Golden Bengal has been formed, which proclaims that 50,000 people are required to die for their country, and adds: "Why cry any more! Beat the Sabits! Drive them away!" etc.
