Morning Program

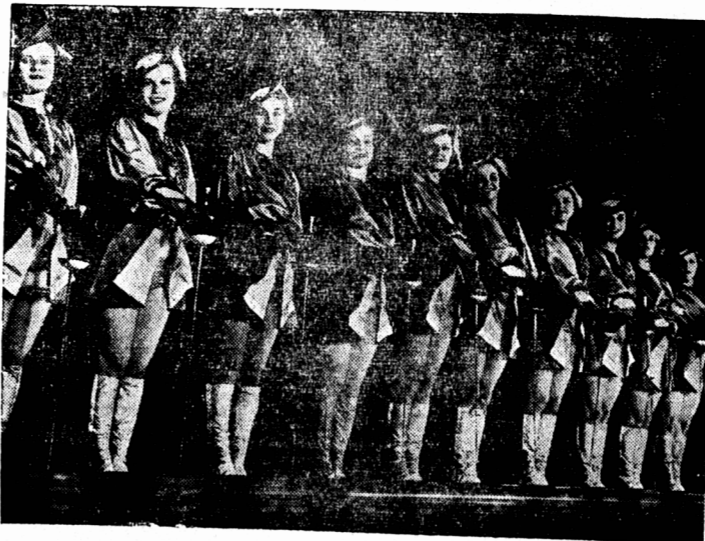
