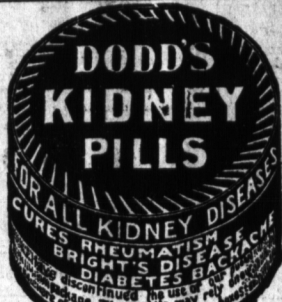

That is as 1 to 5 of the population of Toronto and 1 to 44 of the population of Ontario.

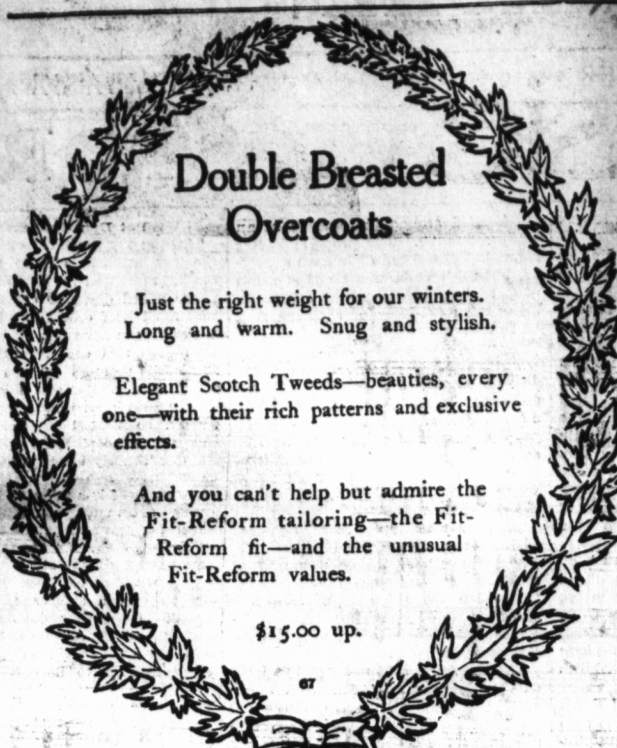
