Hints for the Motorist

ANNNOYING ENGINE VIBRATION

C. R. C. writes: My car vibrates so badly at speeds from 25 to 30 miles per hour as to make driving very unpleasant, the vibration being noticeable as to the steering column, windshield, emergency-brake lever and gear shift. Is there anything that can be done about this?

Answer: The first thing for you to do is to find out whether other cars of the same make and model vibrate as badly as yours. If this proves to be the case, it is unlikely that there is any practical remedy, design and construction of the engine, M. on the other hand, you find that yours vibrates worse than others, there is hope that you can secure some improvement. We assume that this vibration is from the engine and, this being the case, it is possible that the individual piston and connecting rod units are not of equal weights, that the crankshaft or flywheel is slightly out of balance, among the cylinders. If even the radiator fan is unbalanced it will make noticeable vibration.

NUMBER OF PISTON RINGS. E. S. asks: In fitting new pistons in my engine would you recommend those having five rings instead of three?

Answer: You would probably find it difficult to secure such pistons and we doubt if it would be worth while. Pistons with three ring-grooves above the wrist pin are practically standard. Many have one additional groove below the pin, but it is becoming usual to omit this. Some manufacturers are using several narrow rings side by side in one or more of the upper upper grooves, but the tendency is toward fewer ring grooves with the idea that a smaller number of rings, well fitted, is better or as good as a larger number.

THIRD SPEED DISENGAGES. C. A. R. writes: The third speed of my car gives trouble by slipping out of engagement. Can you suggest a remedy for this?

Answer: If you will remove the transmission cover, you may be able to locate the trouble. Put the gear into third speed and examine the two part jaw-clutch, which looks the clutch shaft and the final drive shaft together. If the jaws are rounded off, by wear, instead of being flat, this may be the difficulty. Make sure that the two parts of the jaw-clutch come together fully as if not, there will be a tendency for them to throw apart. Examine the spring plunger, which should lock this speed in mesh and see that it is fully seated in its notch. When the shifting lever is in third, also examine the plunger spring and see that it is strong and free to hold the plunger in position. We think that your trouble may be in this look, in the adjustment of the shifter yoke or some other part of the shifting mechanism or in the condition of the jaw-clutch.
