Investments in Dominion and Provincial securities, municipal, railway and other bonds and securities, all shown at not exceeding market value, are \$127,022,096, an increase of \$5,403,057.

Profits, after making provision for Dominion and Provincial taxes of \$535,878, and after appropriations to contingent accounts, out of which full provision for bad and doubtful debts has been made, amount to \$1,960,770, down only \$1,970 from the previous year.
