THE SUFFRAGETTES MEET OBSTACLES

LONDON, Dec. 17, (Special)—Miss Zelia Emerson, the American suffragette, who was arrested yesterday, was charged in the Thames Police Court this afternoon with disorderly conduct and fighting the police with flagstaffs.

She was remanded in bail to enable her to obtain legal aid.

She said the police behaved like Cossacks and had twisted her arm, which she carried in a sling, nearly off.

The police testified that Miss Emerson had smashed in a policeman's helmet with the pole of a suffrage banner she was carrying.

Miss Sylvia Pankhurst, since her incarceration on December 10, has adopted the more drastic method of adding a "sleep strike" to her "hunger and thirst strike" in order to force the prison authorities to release her. She accomplishes this, it was said today, by continually walking.

In the meantime the militant women continued their violent tactics by burning an empty mansion near Bristol and breaking every window in the Richmond police station.

Suffragette literature found on the site of a timber yard and adjoining property at Devonport, where a fire occurred today, causing damage estimated at \$400,000, leads the police to believe that the militant suffragettes were the perpetrators of the outrage.

P. E. I. FOX KING IN MONTREAL HOSPITAL

"Prosperity such as its citizens never hoped for is in store for Prince Edward Island," said Hon. Charles Dalton, millionaire, of Charlottetown and pioneer of the fox farming industry in the Maritime Provinces. Mr. Dalton is in the Royal Victoria Hospital, where he underwent a minor operation last week, says the Montreal Mail.

There is almost no limit to the possibilities of the fox industry in P. E. Island. Mr. Dalton thinks, while in addition, the inauguration of the improved ferry service with New Brunswick will revolutionize the agricultural industry of the province.

"Prince Edward Island is producing the finest quality of foxes in the world. Whether it is the climate or the careful breeding selections that is responsible, Alaska, Russia, Labrador or any other country cannot raise as fine animals," said Mr. Dalton.

"There is no fear of the industry dying out or of the prices taking a slump," continued Mr. Dalton. "When foxes become so plentiful that the breeders are willing to sell the skins, the price for the poorer quality will drop, but there will always be fur fanciers who will pay big prices for the best quality."

Instancing the profit to be made in the fox ranching industry in Prince Edward Island, he said he had sold his twenty pair of animals last year for \$625,000, or over \$30,000 a pair. Twenty-five skins sent to London three years ago sold on an average for \$1,400. For \$100 he had purchased a pair of foxes and started the business a quarter of a century ago. He had done so mostly to satisfy his liking for animals and with a rather vague idea that there might be money in the business.

Mr. Dalton thought that the inauguration of the new ferry service would see the farmers of the Maritime Provinces sending more foxes direct to Montreal as they could be sent in heated cars in the coldest weather without fear of freezing.

VOLCANO WHELMS AMBRIM ISLAND

MELBOURNE, Dec. 17, (Special)—Despatches from Noumea, capital of the French colony of New Caledonia, report that great destruction has been wrought by a volcanic eruption in Ambrim Island, of the New Hebrides group.

Six new craters were formed on the west coast on December 6. The following day Mount Minnie collapsed and many villages were overwhelmed by streams of molten lava. The majority of the inhabitants sought refuge in canoes and boats and a steamship rescued five hundred of them.

No casualties are reported among the white population, whose numbers are small, but it is feared that many natives in the interior perished.

Ambrim Island is about fifty miles in circumference and is somewhat sparsely inhabited.
