PRESS DENOUNCES AQUITH'S BILL

The Licensing Bill Is Sharply Criticized By The Opposition Press

LONDON, March 2.—Chancellor Asquith's bold and drastic licensing bill, which was introduced in the House of Commons yesterday, in raising a storm of denunciation in the Opposition press. Mr. Balfour gave his party a lead in a brief speech stigmatising the measure as "robbery." The tremendous strength of the brewing interests throughout the country will be brought to bear in an endeavor to prevent the passage of the bill or to obtain an extensive amendment, especially as in the direction of securing a longer time limit than four years, which is regarded likely to inflict serious injury to the interests of the shareholders of brewing companies representing a capital of 9200,000,000. Some of the Unionists regard the bill as another move in the campaigning against the House of Lords. The best opinion in the lobby, however, favored the view that Mr. Asquith is asking much more than he hopes to obtain and that the bill would pass in greatly amended form.

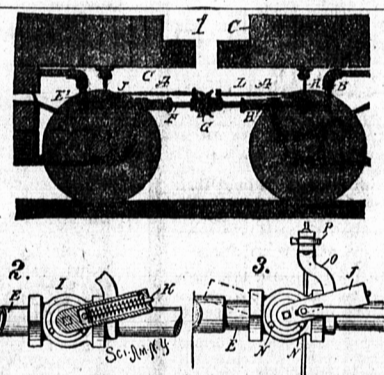

AUTOMATIC COUPLER FOR AIR-BRAKE PIPES. Pictured in the accompanying engraving is an improved coupler arranged to automatically connect air-break pipes of railroad cars while in the act of coupling the cars, to form a continuous passage for the flow of compressed air from one car to another without danger of leakage. The apparatus also comprises means for closing the air-break pipes whenever desired, as when making up a train. FEATURES OF THE AUTOMATIC PIPE COUPLER (1) Being all metallic, excepting ends having flexible cushions when coming together, so ends are air-tight. (2) Can stand unlimited pressure where the present hand hose coupler can't stand over 70 pounds of air pressure. (3) Saving expense of replacing the weather worn hand hose which costs over a million dollars yearly. (4) This new device will cutlive the life of any car attached to. (5) Trainmen stand no chances going between the cars at the risk of their lives. (6) Cars going around direct curve without changing position of automatic device. (7) Lever "J" has increased spring to take up excess play in the draw bar. (8) D is a stationary jack with perpendicular and lateral spring inposed to overcome the irregular motion of the cars. (9) B is air pipe from main air reservoir with swivel slide attachment of device on stationary jack D.
