failure of Lapointe's halibut treaty to pass the U. S. Senate, clearly established their feebleness and incapacity.

Feeble and languid, indeed, the King Government has proved itself to be in doing anything for the substantial benefit of Canada, for the Maritime Provinces or for Prince Edward Island. As for Nova Scotia or our own province, they rest assured of the hearty support of all the representatives equally whether ministers do anything or nothing for the eastern section of the Dominion. Except in voting for and with the government when their votes are required the members for the two provinces named appear to be as languid and as feeble as the ministers, and with one or two exceptions, as silent as they are idle and inefficient.

The time was when Prince Edward Island was heard from in Parliament and had influence there, when our needs and requirements were forcibly presented and properly attended to. What a contrast between those days and these. Even under the Laurier government Prince Edward Island had upon occasion an influential voice in the councils of the Dominion, but where are we now in that regard? If, as Mr. Meighen truly says, the King government is "the most feeble and languid" in the entire history of the Dominion, what shall be said of the languid and silent deputations who are so feebly content to vote "yea" to every ministerial proposal?

Two years these gentlemen have sat in their seats in Parliament, apparently well content that half our railway mileage is still of the narrow gauge, with dilapidated engines and cars, powerless to force their way through the winter snows, relics of a past age and sole relics in all the broad Dominion of that sort. Well content are they that their constituents shall pay first class fares for second class accommodation in cars that cramp their limbs and squeeze their bodies as they clatter along; well satisfied
