The Tsetse Fly.

How great a menace is the tsetse fly to the progress of certain regions of Africa is shown in the report of Sir William H. Manning, governor of Nyasaland. The prevalence of the fly has made it necessary to close many important roads against all forms of animal transport. One of the highways thus closed to animal-drawn vehicles is the road between Blantyre, the chief commercial centre of the country, and Zomba, the administrative capital; but 23 miles of it, or more than half, has been macadamized, in order that motor vehicles can use it; and work on the remainder is going on rapidly. The ordinary roads of the country are impassable for ox-wagons during the rainy season, which extends from November to May. For this reason a great increase of macadamized highways is desirable. Unless it is provided, the newly-developed agricultural settlements of the protectorate will suffer greatly.

Famous Banyan Tree.

One of the most wonderful trees in the world is the famous banyan tree in the Botanical Gardens in Calcutta, India, which covers two and one-half acres of ground. This tree fills a visitor with admiration and awe.

The utmost care is taken of this wonderful growth, for every tender young root, as it begins to fall like a stalactite from the branch overhead, is encased and protected from harm in a bamboo. It is expected that this particular tree, nursed and nurtured like a baby, will within the next 50 years, cover at least 15 acres of ground. It is supposed to have 1,500 aerial roots. The mother trunk is an almost shapeless mass by this time and contributes very little to the sustenance of its multitudinous progeny.

The banyan tree flourishes in India as in no other part of the world, although they do reach an enormous size with hundreds of roots—in some other lands.

Charity Dogs.

Prince, the five-year-old black retriever at Reading Station, collected £45 last year for the Great Western Railway Orphanage in London. Altogether since he started he has added over £150 to his record, at the rate of £1 a week.

Prince generally begins work at 8.30 in the morning and has a twelve-hour day of it. He has an hour's sleep between twelve and one. Every train that comes in he meets, and stands on his hind legs at the carriage doors begging for coppers. He knows every train on which there is a restaurant car, and always expects a bone or a scrap of meat.

Prince by no means holds the record for collecting, or anywhere near it, as a matter of fact. Tim, an Irish-Airedale terrier, now, alas! stuffed and on view at Paddington Station, collected over £1,000. The Great Western Railway have many dogs like Tim collecting for them. The forerunner of all these canine collectors is supposed to have been Help, a Scotch collie which belonged to a guard named Climpson. Help started collecting in 1882, and died nine years later, after wheeling over £1,000 out of passengers. Like Tim, he is stuffed, and still manages to collect about £20 a year.

POWDERED CANE SUGAR.

An English Physician Says It is a Powerful Heart Stimulant.

Sugar has had its champions as well as its opponents. Its advocates have declared that, aside from its nourishing value, it carries with it a quick stimulation that is without perceptible reaction.

"On the other side," says the Bakers Weekly, "we have had radical utterances connecting sugar with some of the most incurable of organic diseases. But an English physician recently contended that cane sugar is almost a specific in the treatment of certain diseases of the heart. Emphasis is laid upon cane sugar."

Dr. F. S. Locke of King's college, London, has kept the heart of a mammal beating for eighty to ninety hours after death of the animal simply by keeping the heart muscles sprinkled with powdered cane sugar. These latter experiments with cane sugar, especially with reference to dilation of the heart muscles, show that in numerous cases cures have been effected that are of three or four years' standing.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties.—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
