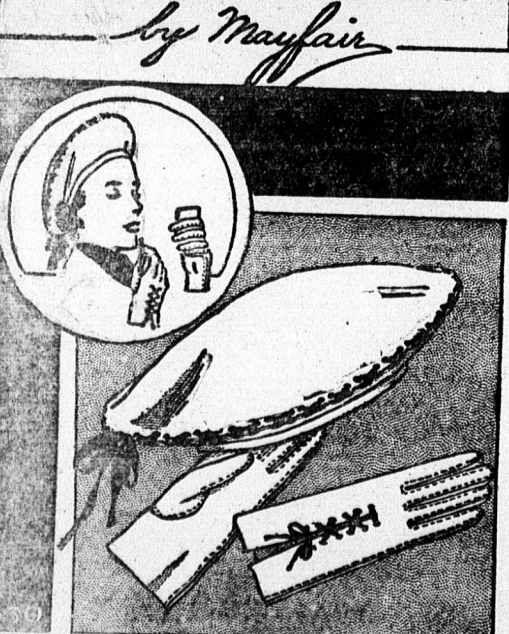
I trust that every woman who reads these lines will ponder well, and inwardly digest, the lessons taught by these two cases.

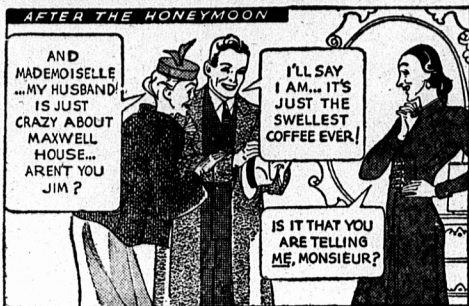

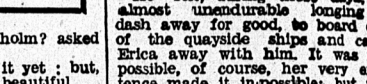
