**Stock Markets New York At A Glance**

**WINNIPEG, May 7 (CP)** - Rye futures retreated from early moderate gains on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today and prices finished five to three cents a bushel lower.  
**CHICAGO, May 7 (AP)** - Profit cashing, which uncovered stop loss orders, depressed the May rye contract the five-cent daily limit in closing grain futures trading here today. Rye was strong at the opening, reflecting the full daily limit advance at Minneapolis. Moving in a fairly wide range, on small deals prices held above yesterday's finish until the closing half hour.  
**MONTREAL, May 7 (CP)** - The stock exchange and curb market closely followed the upturn in prices in New York today after the slump on Monday. All key groups were marked up in the indices except gold which went to a new 1946 low. Among individual issues selected liquors showed strength as reaction to rumors of a split in the stocks.  
**NEW YORK, May 7 (AP)** - The stock market rallied today, on the anniversary of victory in Europe. St. hopes for a break in the coal strike stalemate revived and accounts were reinstated on the idea the list had been over-riding five successive declining sessions.  
The 90-stock composite was up 1.1 points on the day at 87.7. It is the widest advance since April 3.  
**TORONTO, May 7 (CP)** - Stocks registered a smart recovery this afternoon on the Toronto Exchange, moving in sympathy with the rally in Wall Street where expectation of an early end of the coal miners' strike prevailed. All indices were up at the close. The base metal stocks gained .38, the golds .46 and the Western oils .11.  
Recovery in the gold list developed mainly in the cheaper issues. After selling at 70, Eudora climbed to close at 78, up 7 cents net. Goldvue gained 8 cents, closing at 75. Sticks-Masco added 15 cents. Malartic Gold fields added 9. O'Brien 10 and Sullivan 20. Gains of 10 to 20 cents were held by Amcor, East Sullivan, Frohisher, Lunenburg, Macleod-Cookshut, Nevers, Picoadilly, Shawkey, Sinden and Theobald-Lundmark. Giant gained 20 cents.
