BOSTON BROWN BREAD.

One cupful rye meal, 1 cupful granulated corn meal, 1 cupful Graham flour, 1 1/2 teaspoonfuls soda, 1 teaspoonful salt, 3 cupfuls molasses, 2 cupfuls sour milk or 1 1/2 cupfuls sweet milk.

add molasses and milk, stir until well mixed, turn into a greased mould (a one-pound baking-powder can makes an attractive loaf) and steam 3 1/2 hours. The cover should be buttered before being placed on the mould, and then tied down with a string, and the mould should never be filled more than two-thirds. For steaming place mould on a saucer in a kettle of boiling water, allowing the water to come half-way up around the mould. Cover closely to steam adding more boiling water as needed.

We did quite a lot of fighting this summer, but I have been very lucky all through, although I have been gassed.

I hope this awful war will soon be over so we all can get back to dear old Canada. I had a letter from Willie Cook, sometime ago, and he told me all the news. Well Dear what all is going on in Valleyfield; not much I guess, but you are in a safe country and you ought to be thankful for that, but I hope the boys from around home will enlist and do their bit for their country. I am glad I came over to France to fight and I will come back if God spares me when this war is over, but we are winning and that is one good thing. We drove old Fritz quite a ways back this summer.

How is Uncle William's crowd getting along. I never came across uncle Alex's Jim yet. I wish you would send me his address.

O guess I must stop for this time for I am not allowed to tell much about the war. Tell Christine to write to me. Love to all, not forgetting yourself from your loving brother.

POTATO BREAD.

Three pounds potatoes, 1 cupful lukewarm water, 5 to 6 cupfuls whole wheat flour, 1 1/2 tablespoonfuls salt, 2 tablespoonfuls sugar, 2 cakes compressed yeast softened in 1/2 cupful lukewarm water.

Boil the potatoes in their skins until very soft. Pour off the water and peel and mash the potatoes while hot. When the potatoes are lukewarm, add the dissolved yeast cakes, then the other cupfuls of water, and the salt and sugar. Mix into this one scant cupful of flour, and allow the sponge to rise two hours. Add the remainder of the flour and knead thoroughly until the dough is smooth and elastic. Let rise until nearly double in volume, then knead and shape into loaves. Let these rise to double their volume and bake.
