Is hereby given that application will be made to the Parliament of Canada at the next session for an act to incorporate "The Shipping Federation of Canada," having its head office at the City of Montreal, with the following objects: To amalgamate and federate shipowners, steamship and ship managers and agents, whether individuals or corporations existing or future, and such other persons and corporations as may from time to time be interested in the shipping trade of Canada, to act jointly by federation, amalgamation or otherwise and to cooperate with any other association, company or person; to consider all questions and matters affecting the interests of the Shipping Trade of Canada or other trades connected therewith and to take such steps as it may deem advisable to promote and protect all such interests; to acquire, own and dispose of movable and immovable property; to organize, regulate and dissolve branches; to protect and indemnify its members as it may see fit; to provide for the arbitration of disputes; to make by-laws, rules and regulations for its government, for the carrying out of its objects, for the imposition of fees, calls, subscriptions and penalties upon its members; and to possess all the other usual, necessary or incidental rights, powers or privileges as may be necessary or incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.
