The Men's Missionary Convention to be held in the Maritime Provinces in November promise to duplicate in power and influence the great Congress held in Toronto, April, 1909, from which is dated so much of the advance in missionary interest and service by the Churches of the Dominion. They should prove a much greater force, because of the much larger number of points touched and the greater body of men in attendance. No such force of leaders and speakers has participated in any of the series of missionary gatherings in Canada, and a few single meetings have brought together such a group of leaders. Among the speakers scheduled for each of the Eastern Conventions is Mr. J. Campbell White of New York, who spent the past summer in a visit to China, the Pacific to the Atlantic, Mr. White known as the General Secretary of the Laymen's Missionary Movement, with which he has been identified from the very first, and it is because of his visions, his intense earnestness and his splendid leadership that the Movement has won for itself such a remarkable place in the life of the Church in less than five years. When the first series of meetings was held in Canada by the Laymen's Movement in the autumn of 1908, extending from the Convention at Halifax is to be on Nov. 22nd, 23rd and 24th.
