DROWNING OF HECTOR MCDONALD OF THIS PROVINCE

Accidently Drowned At Skagway On The Eve Of Leaving To Visit Friends At San Francisco—Formerly Belonged To Garfield

The following account of the death of a native of this Province is taken from a recent issue of the Skagway, Alaska.—After having been employed for a long time in the interior, part of which he acted for the Guggenheims as Master

Builder at 90 below, on Bonanza Creek, and on the eve of his departure on a visit with relatives in San Francisco, Hector McDonald, last night a few minutes before 8 o'clock while attempting to make his way across the dock to the Princess Royal, which was about to leave, tripped over a guard rail, wheeled suddenly, fell backward into the bay and was drowned.

George F. Woolfolk, mate of the dead man, and who has been with him all summer was with McDonald at the time, "I was with him when we neared the pile which comes up from the water that is used to snub the boats on," said Mr. Woolfolk to the Alaskan. McDonald walked around this and tripped on Guard rail turning a half circle towards where we were standing, fell backwards and disappeared under the waters. I called for help and for a line. A boat was lowered from the Henrietta. The searchlight was turned on and we at once began an attempt to rescue. I heard no cry from McDonald. I saw him a few seconds after he came up. Evidently the poor fellow was making an attempt to reach one of the piles under the dock. When I left him to run for the line he was swimming for the piling. It is my opinion that he was seized with cramps. The tide at that time was coming in and I searched all night for his body, but fear that it may have been carried out by the early tide this morning. I have telegraphed to his friends at San Francisco and will remain until I get instructions from them."

McDonald was about 41 years of age and was a native of Garfield Prince Edward Island, and was son of the late Finlay McDonald.

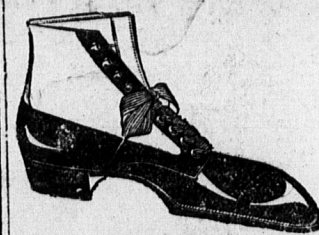
