BABIES DECREASE THE RENT BILL

New York Landlord Adopts Novel Plan to Please Tenants.

NEW YORK, Jan. 12.—The baby market has gone up. Agenerous landlord has put a premium on the "cunning things," and with every new arrival rents will decrease. Every girl baby born in the tenement houses at No. 71 Clinton street, or Nos. 133-135 Broome street, will depress the rent 50c per month; every boy who arrives hereafter is equivalent to a \$1 reduction; twins will cause \$3 to be stricken from the monthly rent bill, and triplets are to be worth \$10. And in addition a bonus of \$10 has been offered for the first child born during the new year.

The benevolent landlord who has made the above propositions to the parents of the tenement houses is a bachelor, Dr. Charles L. Singer. He is the proprietor of the two tenement houses and practises dentistry in his office at No. 71.

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Summary of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 28, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section (60 s. more or less).

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may be made at an agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of any intending homesteader. The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
