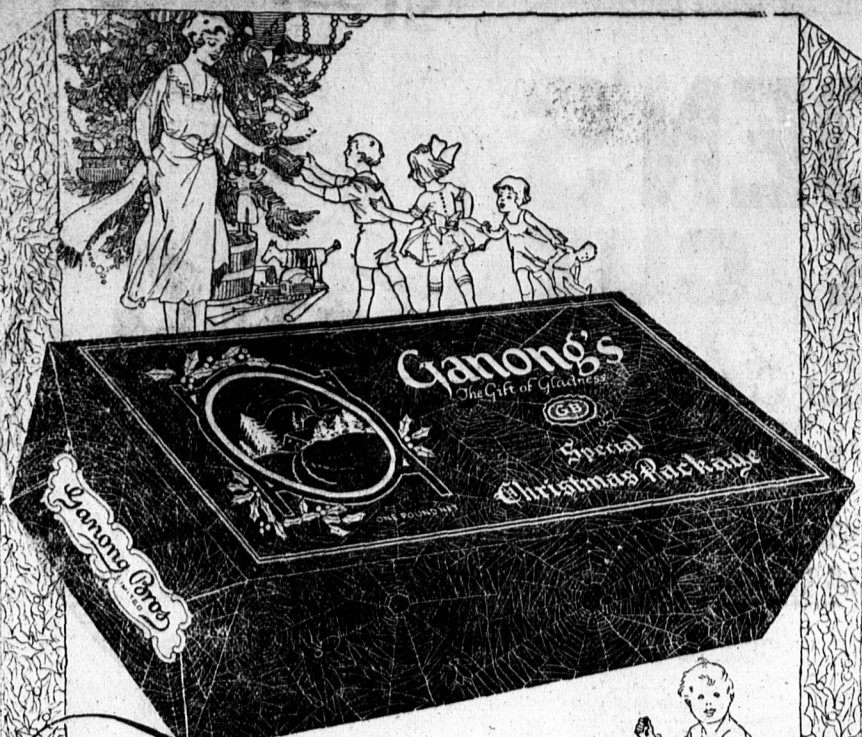

### ICEBERGS IN ATLANTIC

WASHINGTON, Dec. 14.—Owing to the "constant prevalence of icebergs" in the North Atlantic steamship lanes, the double-track route of the regular liners has been shifted to the summer or southern
