—ANOTHER FOX STEAL.—Fox thieves are again at work in Prince County. Wednesday night the ranch of Christopher Carruthers and George Barbour at Bloomfield was entered and a valuable pair of black breeders stolen. This is the second robbery in Prince County within a short time and the culprits have not yet been captured and no clue has been discovered as to who they are.

The case of W. W. Harper, contractor, Fitzroy St., Charlottetown, vs. Mrs. Egan, which was before the Supreme Court this last four days was given to the jury yesterday morning after the Chief Justice's charge which occupied about half an hour.

The case was one of trespass and was the result of a dispute concerning the line fence the plaintiff claiming that the defendant tore down his fence thereby damaging his property. The plaintiff's contention was that the defendant's house was built on the line, the defendant claiming that it was not on the line but at sufficient distance to allow banking.

Among the witnesses examined were surveyors May and Hooper, Marshall Cameron, who formerly owned the house, Charles McGregor, who built the house, the plaintiff, Mr. Harper and relatives, the defendant and her relatives, A. A. McLean, K. C., and MacKinnon appeared for the plaintiff, Johnson, K. C., and Palmer, K. C., for the defendant. At 1.45 the jury came down and reported that they found a unanimous verdict for the defendant.

The next case was S. H. White and Co. vs. Samuel A. Cannon, defendant. Stewart, K. C., appeared for plaintiff and McQuarrie, K. C., for defendant. The judge ruled in favor of plaintiff.
