THE NEWSPAPER GETS THERE.

In the course of a recent lecture in Hartford, Conn., on "The Making of a Newspaper," Charles Hopkins Clark, of the Conrant, said:

"How are you going to get at the public Mail them circulars, and the waste baskets in 10,000 homes give each a wear-yawn, and the circular disappears unread. Call upon the people and explain the merits of your wares. The sign 'Our Busy Day,' hangs in business offices; in private houses you must ring the bell. Oftenest you are turned away. If you get in by any shrewd excuse, you cannot go beyond the hall or reception room—you are quietly watched in the interests of overcoats and umbrellas.

"But put a cleverly worded advertisement of these wares in a newspaper that has an established circulation in the city's home and business houses, and see what happens. You couldn't get in there yourself, but your advertisement is there on the breakfast table, in the library, in the parlor, in the sewing room, and when everybody is inquiring for the paper which can't be found, it is very likely doing duty on the quiet in the kitchen. It is all over the house and wanted then. You are not. Similarly, at the office it is read and reread, and part of the use of 'This is Our Busy Day' sign is to get the chance to read the papers. And it is interesting to note the advertisement has another than a commercial use. It is printed for business purposes pure and simple; but it is often read as news."

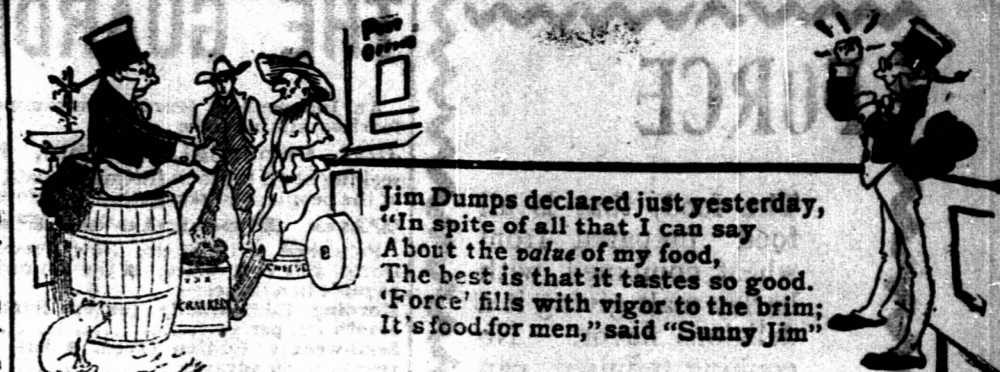
