BERLIN, Jan. 31—Mrs. Pauline Woerner, a leading German advocate of women's rights as that subject is understood in this country, has written an article for the magazine Die Deutsche, in which she advocates compulsory domestic service for the girls or young women of this country. In her article Frau Woerner indorses the generally accepted view that arbitrary military service has enormously benefited German manhood mentally, morally and physically, and she contends that German womanhood would be equally aided by a training along similar lines. She asks if German women would not in time thank the Government for bestowing a boon upon them?

CHURCH TO HAVE BIG LOVE-MAKING PARLOR

ST. LOUIS, Jan. 31—A big club parlor, with easy chairs and cosy corners, advantageous shadows, a gas log and chimney hearth, are the agents with which the Rev. J. B. MOVING PICTURE CRAZE IS ON IN RUSSIA.

Moving picture shows in Russia have become so popular that practically every town and hamlet throughout the empire boasts of at least one of those places of amusement, according to Consul General John H. Snodgrass. At Moscow there was such a rush to open the places that the police had to interfere because of complaints of building inspectors and for other reasons, to insure safety of patrons. Moscow and St. Petersburg boast of about eighty shows each. A rough estimate of the places of amusement is given at 1,200 and the patrons last year aggregated 108,000,000. At an average admission of twenty cents, \$21,600,000 was taken in.

TOLEDO, O., Jan. 31—Mrs. Florence Phillips of Maumee, without being required to offer any defence to a charge of stealing \$700 from her husband, was acquitted by a jury yesterday. The indictment charged grand larceny.
