The fishermen of Murray Harbor West met with some thrilling adventures during the gales which swept the coast in the past week. Capt. William Butler left the shore on Thursday last with his boat heavily laden with lobster traps and after running some three miles from shore the unexpected came upon him and he was blown far to leeward of the fishing grounds. His boat was filling with water and in a disabled condition and he was on the verge of giving up when Capt. Russell came to his assistance and with considerable difficulty succeeded in rescuing him and his mate, Capt. Walter Fraser, on the same day, was some five miles from land in a gas-line boat when his engine gave out and after drifting helplessly for five hours was at last picked up by the schooner Hunter and towed into Murray Harbor.

PEER LOSES IN EIGHTY YEAR FIGHT.

LONDON, May 3.—The Tichborne trial and the more recent Druce case were very brief, petty affairs compared with the "battle of the standards," which has just been settled by the House of Lords after eighty odd years.

Since the reign of George IV a right has been going on as to who has the right to be the official standard bearer to the King of Scotland. It was somewhere in the eleventh or twelfth century that the honor was granted for the first time to Sir Alexander Carron for an act of bravery on the field of battle. At the same time the family name was changed to Scrymgeour, or "fool fighter," Henry Scrymgeour Wedderburn head of the existing senior line of the family, claimed the office as hereditary.

However, in the pleasant latter half of the seventeenth century, one of those periods in history when there was nothing that money could not buy, it is said that the Earl of Lauderdale, the name responsible for the last letter of the famous "Cabal," bought the office, and the present Earl claimed it accordingly. The Lords have decided in favor of the Wedderburn family.

CABINET OF SILVERWARE FOR CHIEF LIBERAL WHIP

OTTAWA, May 3.—N. N. Pardee, the Chief Whip of the Liberal party, was tonight given a substantial proof of the manner in which his members appreciate his services in that capacity, when he was called to the Liberal Room, No. 16, and was there greeted with cheers by a majority of the members of the party. Representatives in the Commons, Sir Wilfrid Laurier, presented to the Chief Whip a handsome cabinet of silverware comprising 120 pieces, enclosed in a handsome chest lined with silk.

### H. W. DEFOREST'S CREDITORS CALLED

ST. JOHN, May 4.—A meeting of the creditors of the H. W. DeForest company, limited, wholesale tea, merchants, and proprietors of the Union Blend Tea, has been called for tomorrow afternoon. The firm is reported to have assigned to L. P. D. Tjelly, of this city. Liabilities are said to amount to \$139,000, but no exact figures are available.

Most of the creditors are in the United States, where a branch of the concern was opened in Boston some time ago.

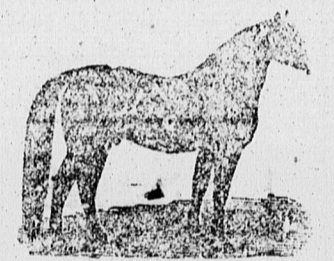

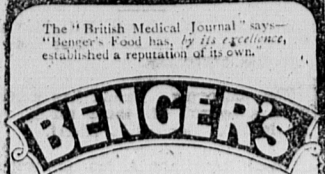
