HALF A MILLION IN ADVERTISING

Apart altogether from the merits of the case which the Tobacco Commission is investigating, an interesting feature of the evidence presented has been the disclosure of the amount of money which the two companies against which complaint has been made—the American Tobacco Co. and the Empire Tobacco Co.—have expended of late years in advertising. It was stated that the former had spent \$267,961 in exploiting its wares, while the latter company has donated in four years \$250,579 towards the same purpose. This makes a total of \$518,540. It was also stated that the Empire Company, under the former management, had spent but \$2,308 in two years in advertising.

Industrial companies which can spend such sums as those in attracting attention to what they have to sell must be most formidable competitors of traders less fortunately situated, or less impressed with the value of publicity. If the American and the Empire Companies have captured a large share of the Canadian tobacco trade, their liberal expenditure in advertising must be credited with a large share of the result.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY.

It seems now to be a fact, attested by the statement of Marconi himself to the Halifax newspapers, that the Italian warship Carlo Alberto while recently in Sydney harbor successfully received a long wireless message across the Atlantic from the station at Poldhu, Wales. He says it was the longest message ever transmitted by the wireless system and that it was received without difficulty. He declined to say more, for the apparently very good reason that by agreement with the Italian Government they have the right of first making public the result of all experiments made on board their national warship. He further states that since his arrival at Table Head, C. B. further improvements have been made in both the sending and receiving apparatus with the result of being able now to transmit forty words a minute, while a year ago the best speed was sixteen or seventeen words a minute.

Assuming these statements to be true, and we see no reason to doubt their accuracy, it is impossible to overrate their importance. We are on the eve of a new era in the transmission of news, of business and social messages. The cost of sending and receiving stations and their equipment is as cents to dollars compared with the first cost of a cable system. The cost of maintenance and repairs will be proportionately fractional. The Marconi system has no cables to break, or to become defective in their insulation; it requires no cable ships with costly equipment to grapple for, fish up and repair the broken or impaired lines. The cost of repairs and renewals will be confined to the terminals, the sending and receiving stations. This means a merely nominal cost for transmission when once the system becomes successfully operative. It means greatly reduced rates between the old world and the new for business and news transmission.

It means much more than this. It means that in the near future, close on the heels of the completion of the cable system around the globe, there will follow a system of world-girdling stations of the wireless system. In this as in submarine telegraphy Britain will take the lead. Her possessions, her naval and coaling stations, are located on every continent and in every sea. By this new inexpensive and marvellous system they will be connected, and through the wireless air the members of the Great British family can take momentary counsel together when occasion requires, and the whisper will be unheard by foes or rivals. Better still, we may see in this latest marvel a great stride forward in human progress and one further step toward bringing the nations of the earth to gather in brotherly accord.

DR. GORDON FOR QUEENS.

TORONTO, Nov. 20.—Dr. Gordon of the Halifax Presbyterian College was offered and accepted the principalship of Queen's University. The formal appointment will be made on December 5th. Judge McLennan, chairman of the board of Trustees, who resides here, authorized the announcement tonight. Dr. Gordon is to receive \$4,000 a year and house rent free.
