## THE OLD IMPERIALISM.

Rev. Dr. Sheraton Argues That It Has Now Passed Away.

A paper on "The Missionary Outlook," prepared by Rev. J. P. Sheraton, D.D., principal of Wycliffe College, Toronto, was read before a missionary conference of the deanery of St. John, N.B., the other day. The paper began by showing that time and space are now no longer barriers against intercourse with far-off lands. The old imperialism dominated by lust of conquest and love of power was, he trusted, dead. Britons were realizing that a great trust had been committed to them. Britain stood the armed sentinel at the open doors which gave men access to preach the Gospel to myriads of heathens under her protectorate. The greater part of the work was Anglo-Saxon, British protection allowed American missionaries to carry on work in Mohammedan countries. Even in China, where all seemed so dark, a glorious light was beginning to shine, kindled by the fires of persecution. There was much to cause anxiety. The Dowager-Empress might regain her position, and there was fear of Russian intrigue. Christianity was spread in Japan and in Eastern Asia. In Africa the work was going on, its advance being due to the skill of British colonization. The triumph of the British over the natives meant the protection of the Gospel and an open highway for the work demanded more missionaries constantly. There were many hardships, many obstacles, but the life and vigor of the church backing up a vigorous missionary spirit would overcome all and there would resound the joyful psalm "City of God, the bond are free; we come to live and reign in Thee."

The Australian flag was chosen more than 38,000 designs were carefully examined. The competition was originally started by the Australasian Review of Reviews, and as many of the designs were well worth notice the Government took the matter up and offered a reward of £200 for the best suggestion. A board of naval experts was appointed to examine those sent in, and a decision has just been reached.
