Patient Saved By Self Blood

LONDON, Dec. 21 —(CP)—This is the story of another triumph of medical science in the everyday drama of life and death, with death the loser in an odds-on battle. The patient is recovering. When a young woman was brought to the emergency operating theatre of the Croxson General Hospital, death had already counted her as a victim. Stricken with a major haemorrhage, the woman had lost two pints of blood and was sinking rapidly. The surgeons persisted in their efforts to save the woman's life. An anaesthetic was administered. The patient's pulse weakened and eventually the heart stopped beating. Unperturbed, surgeons promptly injected a drug to raise the blood pressure and the heart responded feebly. An incision was then made below the ribs and the heart massaged through the diaphragm. Gradually the heart-beat gained strength. But only half the battle was won. Unable to await a blood donor for transfusion, the surgeons extracted blood from the incision, restored it to the blood stream. Two more pints which had drained into the abdomen were taken after a second incision and transfused by the same method. Successful with these delicate emergency measures, the surgeons were able to proceed with the operation proper.
