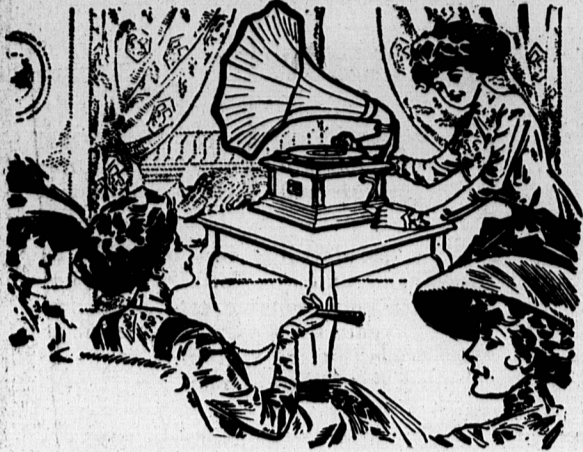

Prehistoric Oyster Shells.

That the oyster was in common use by primeval men has been conclusively shown by the discovery in the "kitchen middens" of Denmark of many thousands of oyster shells, showing every evidence of having been artificially opened.
