WANT INCREASE NO DECREASE
 CHICAGO, Feb. 23.—More than 175 railroads, including every big transportation line in the United States except the Pennsylvania Railroad has filed petitions against wage reductions for all classes of employees when the wage docked closed the United States Railroad Labor Board today.

Unexpected counter proposals for wage increases were filed by several labor organizations in addition to the increase of thirteen cents an hour over the present wage asked by six railway shop crafts unions two months ago.

Lon Bandit Held Up Edmonton Bank
 EDMONTON, Feb. 21.—A daring daylight robbery took place at the North Edmonton branch of the Union Bank at noon today, and the unnamed bandit who held up the manager single-handed at the point of a shotgun made his escape with about \$2,000 in cash. The entire force of the city police are in pursuit of the man, who became lost to view in a bush in the vicinity of Beverley. At ten o'clock tonight no arrests had been made. The bandit appeared alone according to all evidence at hand, although he told the bank manager, S. J. Winsky that a false move would bring bullets from another man. The hold-up man left the bank by the front door and a few minutes after manager emerged and fired three shots after him. That was the first intimation outsiders had of the crime, but they joined in a wholehearted pursuit.

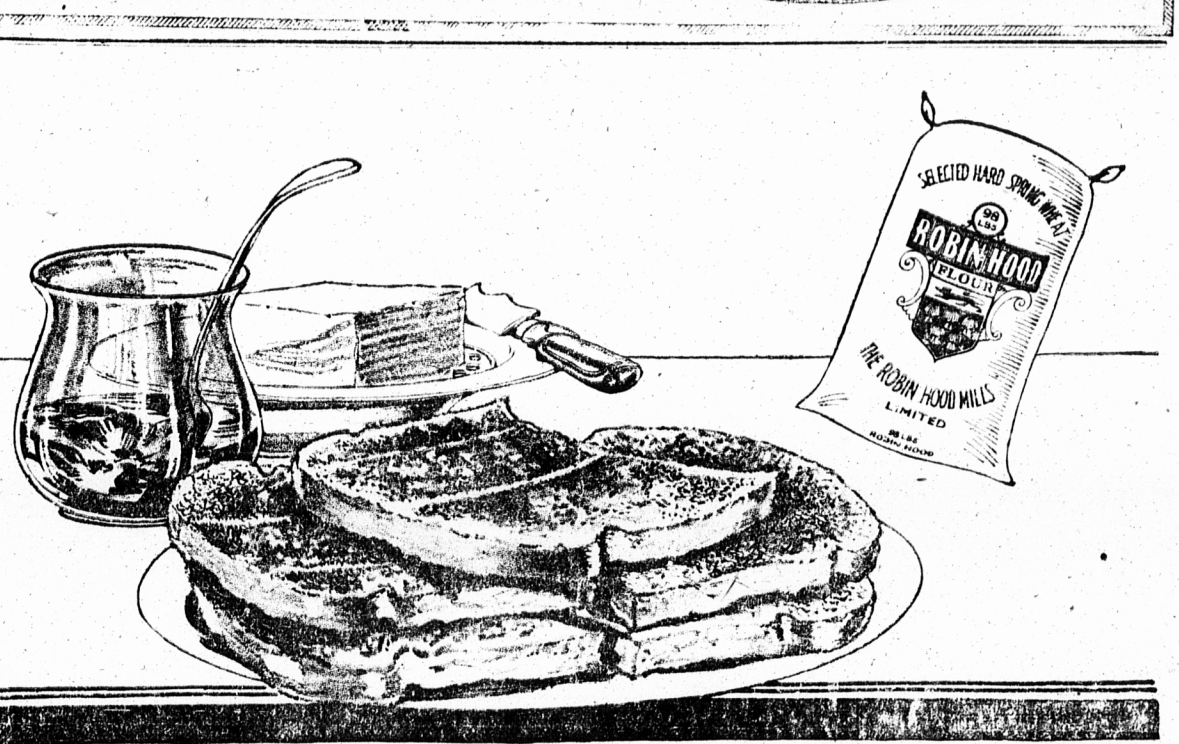
