MAYOR AIDS HANDICRAFT ART

PEIPING, Sept. 26 — The new Mayor of Peiping, Chou Tawen, has announced that he has obtained \$500,000 (silver) to reorganize and encourage the handicraft industry, which employs more than 100,000 persons here and is the source of the city's comparative prosperity. Because of the collapse in silver exchange, buyers from Europe and America have been coming here in larger numbers than ever, and Chinese hand wrought articles in jewelry, cloisonne, and brass, wood and lacquer have displaced similar articles previously bought in Central Europe.
