GIRL MEETS TERRIBLE DEATH IN MONTREAL.

MONTREAL, Sept. 10--An unidentified girl, apparently about 15 years of age, either fell or jumped from the fourth floor of a Notre Dame Street boarding house late last night and was dashed to death. The police are holding Pierre Valade, 21 years old, in whose room the girl is thought to have been, and are instituting a thorough investigation. The girl was only partially dressed when picked up on the sidewalk and blood stains upon her clothing suggested that she had been assaulted and attempted to escape when she met her death.

OAKLAND, Calif., Sept. 9--Secretary of the Interior, Franklin K. Lane, fell in a faint here today while reviewing the Admission Day parade of the Native Sons' organization. He was removed to his brother's home in Berkeley where it was reported that his condition was not serious.

Later all plans for Secretary Lane's departure were abandoned when a diagnosis of his case by a physician called in consultation disclosed a slight attack of angina pectoris. Secretary Lane was ordered to bed and will be kept absolutely quiet for several days. The physicians say that while his case is not serious, absolute rest is necessary.

St. Paul, Minn., Sept. 11--In the modest chapel attached to the archiepiscopal residence, Archbishop Ireland, who, next to Cardinal Gibbons, is perhaps the best known and undoubtedly the most influential member of the American hierarchy, celebrated this morning the mass of thanksgiving that marked the seventy-fifth anniversary of his birth. The Archbishop desired that there be no particular ceremonies. Numerous friends called to extend congratulations, while telegrams and letters of felicitation arrived in large numbers.
