MARITIME PROVINCE FRUIT GROWERS.

Nova Scotia has long been famous for its apples and other fruits of the orchard. Prince Edward Island has in recent years demonstrated that apples can be produced here that are equal in flavor, color and quality to the best in the world.

A word with regard to this company and its work may be in season. It is made up of a number of business men who have purchased nine hundred acres of orchard lands the whole area of which the company is gradually planting with fruit trees.

We have abundance of good orchard land in Prince Edward now devoted to growing oats or other grain crops of a value of \$12 to \$16 per acre, which if properly prepared, planted in fruit trees and well attended for a few years might be producing from \$200 to \$500 per acre.

The trouble with our fruit-growing has been that except for a very few, no one has taken the orchard seriously. A few trees are stuck in the ground and then left to take care of themselves.

These Maritime Provinces ought to be the great orchard of Canada, gardens of bloom in the springtime and of golden fruit in the autumn. Each of the three Provinces is capable of producing the best fruit in abundance and at assured paying prices.

And why may we not have a fruit company, as in New Brunswick, to start the apple-growing business on an extended scale, conducted skilfully and pointing the way to the great possibilities of the fruit culture in this Province?

These are merely suggestions, of course. But it ought to be within the power of the Provincial Government, or of both the Federal and Provincial Governments jointly to stimulate powerfully the development of the great latent resource we have in the fruit-growing capacity of our Island soil.

There is nothing more vital to the welfare of Prince Edward Island than the question of transportation. To keep our people from leaving the Province as they have been doing in thousands, they must be afforded

equal opportunities at home with the people of other Provinces. They must have equal opportunities for shipment of their products, for receiving goods from abroad, for travel to and from other Provinces, for the despatch and receipt of mails, for the establishment and operation of factories and for all-year-round employment.

The question of transportation, beginning with the improvement of the roads, from the farmer's gate, the widening of the gauge of the Island Railway, the immediate operation of a car-ferry, and ultimately continuous rail connection by means of a Tunnel, was the great work which needs attention.

That covers the ground. Any and all who are working for this great end should receive support and encouragement in their efforts.
