THE KING'S COUNTY GUARDIAN

The Georgetown Montague Ferry has resumed running again.

The annual meeting of the Montague Dairymen's Association takes place in McKinnon's Hall tomorrow at 3 p. m.

The Probation case of A. M. Ross, heard last Friday before Stipendiary Magistrate, was dismissed. The case of Peter Delany was adjourned for a week.

Miss Eleanor Gordon, daughter of Walter F. Gordon, Burdett River, left Saturday morning for St. John's to resume her studies at Mt. Allison Ladies' College.

The week of prayer at Montague closed Friday night with service in the Methodist church, led by Rev. Mr. McNeill. There was the largest attendance yet and a collection was taken in aid of the P. E. Island Hospital.

The half yearly examination of the Gasperaux school took place on December 31st, 1906. The children were examined by the teacher, assisted by the secretary, James McKenzie. They acquitted themselves well in all subjects giving their answers quickly and accurately.

The death of Joseph Renton, at Pasadena, on the 27th ult. is announced. He was a son of the late John Renton, of Georgetown, and was 26 years old. He had been away from home only for five years and will be much missed by many friends. General sympathy is felt for his mother and other relatives.

D. H. Logan of Georgetown, keeper of the Kings County Jail was appointed keeper of the jail and chief of the Supreme Court on May 14th, 1904 and has been for nearly 4 1/2 years continuously a Government official, holding office longer than any other Government official in this province. Since becoming chief Mr. Logan never missed a term of the Supreme Court and has seen four Judges pass away during his term of office.

The ceremony was performed by Rev. H. B. McDonald, P. P. Miss Louisa Nolan, sister of the bride, acted as attendant. The happy couple came to Charlottetown by the early train. On the 11th, Mr. and Mrs. McInnes left for their future home in Regina, Sask.

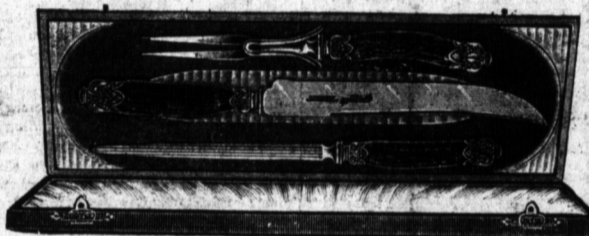
