Contract Bridge

An Important Signal

In yesterday's column I mentioned the fact that one defender must help the other in deciding just when to accept his trick in a certain suit. Let's examine a deal which lends itself admirably to this discussion.

South's dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

♠ 9 7 4	♠ 10 8 6
♥ 3 2 6	♥ K 7
♦ 4 3	♦ A 7 5
♣	♣ 7 6

The bidding: South West North East
1♣ Pass 2♦ Pass
2NT Pass 3NT Pass

West opens his fourth-highest heart. Dummy plays low and East's king holds. Now East leads the heart seven, not only because he hopes to set up his partner's suit but because he is even more anxious to remove dummy's side entry, the heart ace. When South plays the heart ten on the second lead, West knows that South also has the heart jack, but West nevertheless covers in order to knock out dummy's entry.

Now a low diamond is led to the jack -- East, of course, refusing to put up his ace this early in the play. If, however, West's follow-suit play to this trick means nothing, East will be in an insoluble dilemma on the next lead of diamonds. Should East take his ace or should he not? Has declarer another diamond in his hand with which to reach dummy if East does take his ace, or did South start with only two diamonds?

There can be no intelligent answers to these questions except by reference to West's follow-suit plays in diamonds. It is for that reason that a vitally important convention was devised long ago that operates as follows:

When West wants to tell his partner just how many cards of a suit (in this case diamonds) he has, so that East can count declarer's cards in the suit, West plays his lowest card from a holding of exactly three, but he plays a high card, and next a low card, to show either two or four cards in the suit.

Translating this to the above deal, when West plays the diamond deuce on the final lead of the suit, East knows that declarer started with precisely two diamonds.
