TO REMOVE OLD WRECKS—Mr. H. E. Poland of the Marine Department, Ottawa, diver and dynamite expert is in the city and will inspect the several wrecks of vessels lying around the coasts and harbors of this Province. These include one at Craup, one at Cardigan, one at Charlottetown and probably others. It is the intention in about a month's time to blow up all these wrecks which are a menace to navigation and do not tend to improve the appearance of the places where they are situated.

WANT SEASON EXTENDED—The lobster fishermen from Black Point, near Canoe Cove, to St. Peter's Island have petitioned the Government for an extension of ten days of the lobster fishing season. The reason given for this demand are the fact that the season did not open until May 11th and also because of the scarcity of bait. The present season as it stands is the shortest in the history of that section, and the fishermen who were unable to obtain bait, deprived of the profits usually accruing from the fishery will feel the loss severely.

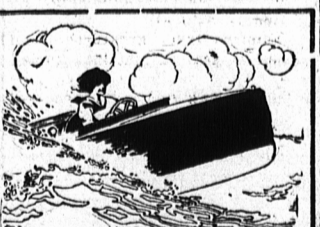

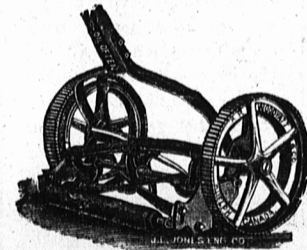

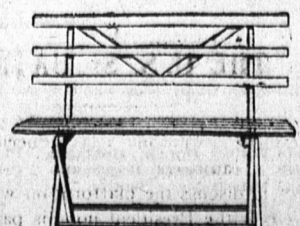
