RUSSIANS MAKE DEMAND ON THE ENTENTE ALLIES

WASHINGTON, May 8.—A demand made on the Entente representatives at Volozda, for removal of the consuls at Vladivostok reached the state department today from Ambassador Francis.

Officials realize that German influences are at work to use the Vladivostok incident as a means of causing trouble between the Allies and the Bolshevik government especially as there have been indications of growing friendliness for the Entente.

The Demands.

The Bolshevik demands on Ambassador Francis were: First the removal of consuls at Vladivostok; second, investigation of his part in the alleged negotiations with the American legation at Peking; and third, the attitude of the American government toward the Soviet republic.

Ambassador Francis sent a communication to the Bolshevik government regarding the alleged participation of Americans, French and British in a Siberian counter-revolution plot in connection with which the Bolsheviks put plainly the question of the recognition of their government.

Russian Declaration.

LONDON, May 6.—A Russian wireless message received here today says: "The ex-chief general com-

mander Ovsienko Antonoff has sent a declaration to the government of the Russian republic, stating that the soviet troops have retreated beyond the frontiers of Ukraine and have been disbanded in accordance with the Brest-Litovsk treaty.

300 ITALIANS KEEP THE AUSTRIANS AT BAY

WASHINGTON, May 9.—One of the most remarkable incidents of the war is related today in this communication from the Italian supreme command:

"One of our prisoners, who escaped from an Austrian camp and succeeded in reaching the Italian lines after a series of thrilling experiences, narrates that at Cimolai, east of Donarone, three hundred Italian soldiers are still fortified in a strong position in the mountain and present the most stubborn resistance to the Austrians."

Cimolai is in the invaded Italian territory, and the Italian soldiers hold the position and assaults for more than six months, as it was last October that the Italian retirement took place.

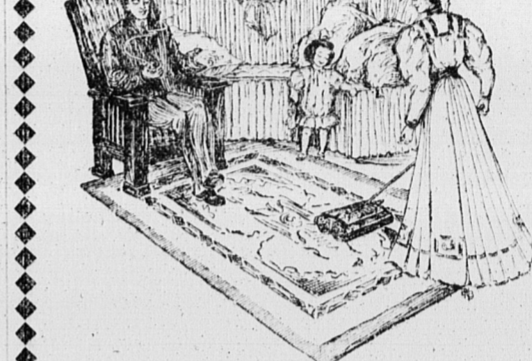

RUSSELLITE HEADS ALL UNDER ARREST

NEW YORK, May 9.—Joseph F. Russell, successor to "Pastor" Russell as head of the International Bible Students' Association, and five other leaders of organizations founded by Russell, were arrested in a raid by federal authorities in the headquarters of the Bible Students' Association in Brooklyn today.

It is charged that the men arrested sought to bring "mutiny, disorder and unrest," and to persuade men to refuse to enter military service by articles published in The Watch Tower, The Bible Student, and The Kingdom News.
