No Falling off In A Grade Hogs

A recent analysis of carcass grading of hogs in Canada shows that there has been no falling off in the percentage of A grade hogs since September 30, 1939 when carcass grading became the only method of grading.

ing Service, Dominion Department of Agriculture, shows that 27.9 per cent of hog carcasses were A grade during the 11.61 nine months of 1940 when carcass grading was optional. After September 30, the percentage remained exactly the same on the average for all Canada until the end of the year. Quality was maintained during the final three months of 1940 in spite of a tremendous increase in the number of hogs marketed.

over the average of 27.9 per cent for 1940 is shown for the first three weeks of 1941. Although this improvement is more or less seasonal in nature it is partly due to an increase in the proportion of hogs marketed at correct weights. A higher percentage of hog carcasses were A grade in January in all provinces except the Maritimes where there was an increase in the number of light hogs marketed.

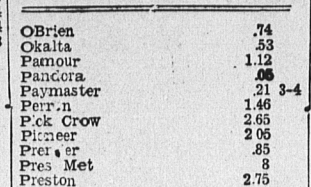
