The Kirk Pulpit

Preaching yesterday the minister, the Rev. G. H. E. Jones, said: "Take first of all the claim that this is the opportune and appropriate season for great advance on the part of catholic Christendom. Across the earth and in every aspect of life several longings for advance, revival, men are working and hoping for a revival of trade, of economic activity, of art and literature and music. It would be strange if churchmen were not equally eager to see forward movement in the domain of faith and morals."

"I believe, all faithful churchmen are concerned and in every part of the world the Christian Communities are marshaling their resources and preparing to go forth to seek new victories for Christ. I read the other day a letter from Geneva avowing the signature of the Very Reverend Doctor Hutchison Cockburn, whose moderate and thoughtful leadership in the Church in Europe is so desperate that the choice is between advance or stagnation."
