BELFAST, Ireland, Oct. 31.—Thirty eight fishermen are missing and 15 are known to have been drowned from small boats during Friday night's gale, says a message from Cleggan, in the north-east corner of Connemara. Most of the missing men were natives of Inishbeefin, which is located about nine miles off Cleggan. Five bodies have been washed ashore.
