EXPERT TO TEST MRS. NAPOLITINA

Many Women's Prayers and Petitions For Her Release From Death Penalty

KINGSTON, June 29—Dr. Daniel Phalen, Surgeon of the provincial penitentiary, and recognized as the Government expert criminalologist, has gone to Sault Ste Marie to report on Mrs. Angelina Napolitina, the young Italian woman under sentence of death for the murder of her husband.

Mrs. Napolitina will die August 9 unless the department intervenes. While the unfortunate woman is preparing for her own death and for her baby's birth, the women throughout the United States and Canada are weaving an endless chain of prayers and petitions for her freedom.

SCHOOL MASTER SHOTS TO KILL

MONTREAL, Que., June 26—With four bullet wounds in his head, one in his hand, two of the bullets having passed through his skull, Alfred Coulombe dashed down Lagache Street last night pursued by Joseph Vallancourt, a school master, with a smoking revolver in his hand. Coulombe who is still living says he accepted Vallancourt's invitation to go to his house and have a drink. They had several drinks and Vallancourt asked his guest to remain for the night. This Coulombe refused to do whereupon his host hurriedly locking all doors drew his revolver and began to fire. In the scramble which followed Coulombe smashed a window in trying to defend himself and finally made his escape. Vallancourt, who is under arrest, declares that the only cause of the quarrel was a question of money and that Coulombe first threatened him.

SAYS THE KING IS REALLY AN EMPEROR

LONDON, June 26—An article signed by J. A. McDonald in the Nation says the essential loyalty of the Dominioners need not any longer be presented, but that royalty is the loyalty of equals, and is offered not to the old-time notion of Empire, but to the newborn ideal which has come in the vision of English-speaking peoples which it is the privilege of British born nations to realize in history.

The word "Empire" is a misnomer. A new significance must be given to the old autocratic terminology on the understanding that the Empire is not in any truth an Empire, and that the King is not an Emperor. We are all of us glad and proud to be citizens of the British Empire, subjects to the King.
