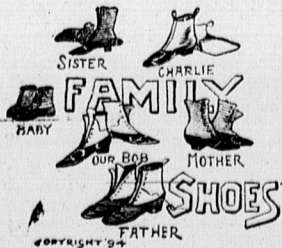

THE STANLEY AND SUMMER-SIDE

The shipping situation at Summerside at the sudden close of navigation was serious, and the demand that the Stanley should be sent to relieve the freight congestion was both just and reasonable.

The sympathy of this City and of the Province generally was with the Western Capital in this matter. At the same time the Minister of Marine had some years ago decided as far as possible to keep the two winter steamers on one route, first from Charlottetown and later on in the season from Georgetown, acting on the opinion of the two captains, and for the safety of the boats, which if plying on one route are in a position to aid each other in any emergency that might arise.

Some of these objections which appear to have been in the Minister's mind, did not apply at the commencement of the season as they might have applied in mid-winter, and especially they did not apply at a time when the Navigation Company's steamer was still plying here

and when the Stanley was not needed here for the moment. But all is well that ends well, and it is only fair to put as favorable a construction as we can upon the action of the Department.

The Northwest grain has been moved promptly this season, more than twice as many cars coming eastward this year before the close of navigation as there was last year.
