Several of the delegates who will represent the local branch at the provincial convention in Toronto, Dec. 16-17 spoke and concurred in the view that the Liberal party should divorce itself from the liquor question. There was also a suggestion that some action should be taken to select a new leader, the opinion being expressed that Hon. W. E. Sinclair had too closely allied himself with the dry forces. No action was taken, however.

G. G. Dynes was of the opinion that the prohibition policy had been settled so far as Ontario was concerned. The Liberals should make it known that they were "absolutely not for prohibition." Agreeing that the L. C. A. was a desirable form of control, provided there was proper control, he held that it should not be made a vehicle for political patronage to the point which he said Premier Ferguson has done. Party workers had the jobs in liquor stores, he added.

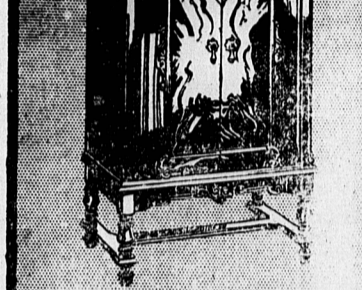

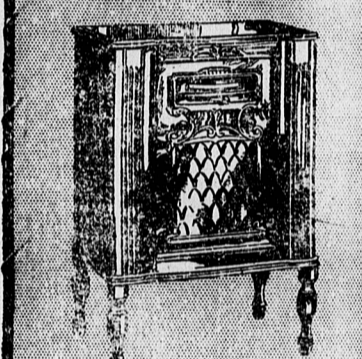

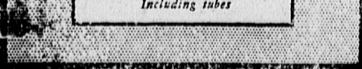
