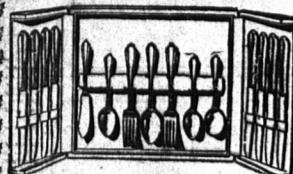

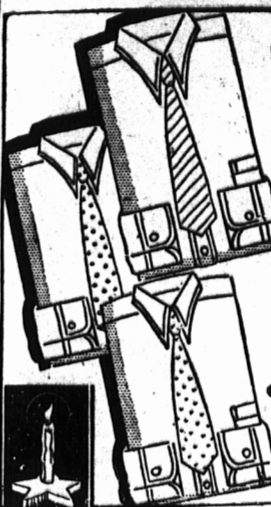

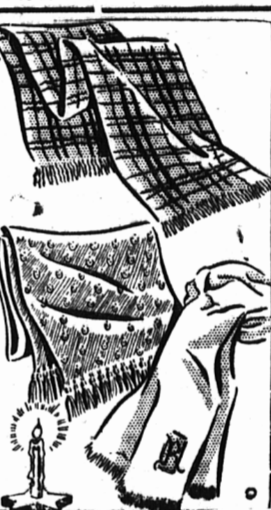

MARSHAL BALBO IS KEPT IN BACKGROUND

ROME, Dec. 19.—Increased tension over Italian colonial possessions in Africa resulting from the Ethiopian troubles has turned the spotlight on Italy's "forgotten man," Marshal Italo Balbo, Governor of Italian Libya.

The calm progress Balbo has made as administrator of this colony was recognized today as standing in sharp contrast against other troubled areas where Italy's announced programme of colonial exploitation in Africa has met with barriers.

Marshal Balbo, the man whose mass flight to Chicago through eastern Canada made him world famous, has re-shaped, re-wrought and rebuilt Libya in his just-completed first year as Governor.

Mussolini's newspaper, "Popolo D'Italia," of Milan, has just published an editorial on Libya. It does not even mention Balbo by name, but says: "It is enough to cross the Mediterranean to perceive with the naked eye how the results accomplished in the economic, political, social and psychological field have not been less than those obtained on the territory of the mother country."

NEW PICTORIAL STAMPS ISSUED ARE ATTRACTIVE

Philatelists have expressed interest in a new issue of stamps produced recently by the Colony of Grenada, in which resides the Governor of the Windward Islands. Three of these large postage stamps show the King's head in the top right-hand corner, with a feature scene in the island, while the other designs carry an impression of the King's head and the arms of Grenada—a caravel and the motto "Clarior. E. Tenebris."

The 1-2d. postage stamp shows a view of Grand Anse Beach, the 1 1/2d. stamp shows a view of the Grand Etang, and the 2 1/2d. stamp has on it a scene of St. George's. The issue is said by philatelists to be one of the most attractive designed in recent years.

Royal Family Name

The family-name of the Royal Family of Great Britain is now Windsor and that also is the name of the Reigning House. This was brought about by Act of Parliament because of feeling against Germany and German connection during the Great War.

King Edward the Seventh was of the House of Saxe-Cobourg and the family of Wettin as the son of the Prince Consort, Albert of Saxe-Cobourg-Gotha. If he had been born a private citizen and had taken the name of his father, he would have been known as Edward Wettin. So, if his son, King George the Fifth, had been born a private citizen he would have taken the name of his father and would have been known as George Wettin and that was his family name before the War. But the Royal Family had a House name as well as a family name. King Edward the Seventh was one of the House of Saxe-Cobourg, and so was King George until, by Act of Parliament, both the House and the family name were changed to Windsor. For the first time in many generations, both the House name and the family name of the British Royal Family are the same—Windsor.
