WESTERN CABINET MAKING.

Alberta's new Cabinet has been announced under the leadership of Premier Rutherford. It consists of five Ministers, four of whom are to have departmental offices and a fifth without portfolio, as follows: Hon. A. C. Rutherford, Strathcona, Premier and Minister of Education, and Provincial Treasurer. Hon. C. W. Cross, Edmonton, Attorney-General. Hon. W. H. Cushing, Minister of Public Works. Hon. W. T. Finlay, Medicine Hat, Minister of Agriculture and Provincial Secretary. Hon. L. G. Deveber, Lethbridge, Minister, without portfolio.

A GOOD WORD FOR RUSSIA.

The literary superintendent of the British and Foreign Bible Society pays a generous and apparently deserved tribute to the Russian Government for giving free transportation to the Scriptures. He says the generous concessions which are made to the Bible Society by the Government and private railways in Russia can show no equal in any other country. The number of railway miles put at the Society's disposal in the Empire of the Czar, without charge for travelling or freight, amounts to not less than a quarter of a million a year.

FEAR MUTINEERS. ODESSA, Sept. 8.—Seven warships of the Black Sea fleet, which arrived here today, brought 3,000 mutineers, sailors from the battleship Georg-Pobedonostsev, the transports Prout and Vechna, and the entire crew of the ironclad Ekaterina II. The mutineers for the present will be distributed in small groups among the troops in the Odessa district. Early in 1906 they will be drafted to the Siberian garrisons. The local military authorities are protesting against the arrangement, fearing the sailors will infect the troops with the revolutionary spirit.
