Who founded these colleges and halls of learning? The Church! In the time of the Reformation, the Church was the only source of moral and ethical education...

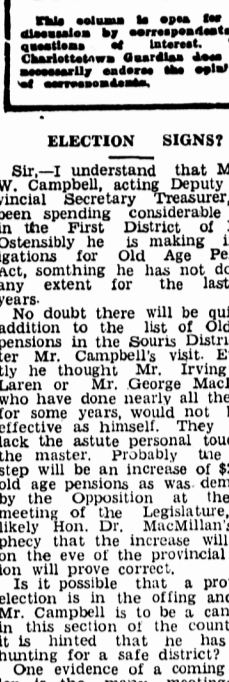
Bow Bells Ring Again

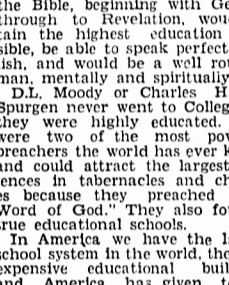
