A native of this Province now "on the Pacific Coast," writes The Guardian as follows:—"Some time ago I decided to take the advice given by Horace Greely and 'go west.' Accordingly I left my happy home on P. E. Island and came as far west as I could get only to find that while a trip from 'Ocean to Ocean' as depicted by the pen of Rev. Edwin Smith of Cardigan furnishes good material for an interesting newspaper article or lecture it is by no means conducive to the health and wealth of the ordinary individual. I found Spokane, Tacoma, Seattle, Vancouver, and even old 'Frisco' swarming with idle men—men who for the most part have been idle since last November.

The labor agencies have fully two hundred men to every job while wages are far below even the Eastern Schedules.—Common laborers 75c-1.00; teamsters \$1.00 to \$1.50; carpenters \$1.50 to \$2.25; engineers (donkey) \$1.75 to \$2.00; and all other in like proportion. Here in Seattle the City laid miles and miles of cement paving this winter paying 25c per day and board while the police had more cases of vagrancy than they could possibly deal with—all vagrants being sent out to work in 'chain gangs' on the roads. Suicides, hold-ups, and all conceivable sorts of crimes are the order of the day or rather the night. It was thought the coming of spring would brighten things up but this does not seem to help matters and many predict that the Coast has yet to see harder times ere the vacation sets in. Let me assure all young men of this Province that walking the streets of a strange city four or five thousand miles from home and mother is not a cheerful undertaking when a man is idle, and prospects of obtaining work exceedingly slim. What with Jews and Italians in most large Eastern Cities and Japs, Chinese and Hindoos in the west it is not a bad idea for the young men of P. E. Island to stay home."

Seven hundred dollars will in future be the indemnity of members of the Nova Scotia Legislature. That was decided on Saturday afternoon, when the motion of which Premier Murray gave notice on the previous day, to increase the indemnity two hundred dollars, was adopted 24-4. In moving this resolution Premier Murray referred to the increases in indemnity which other Legislatures have made. He instanced the recent increase in the Federal House, where the indemnity was raised from \$1,500 to \$2,500. Each political party assumed the responsibility for this increase and he thought that in view of the largely increased legislation in the House during the past few years an increase was necessary. Nova Scotia legislators, with two exceptions, were the lowest paid in the Dominion, and the Premier gave the amounts of the sessional indemnity in the various Provinces. In Ontario, Manitoba, Alberta and Saskatchewan, it is \$1,000. In British Columbia and Quebec it is 3500. New Brunswick it is \$500, and in P. E. Island it is \$200.

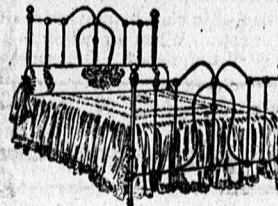
