### VEDRINES HERO OF BATTLE IN THE AIR

Germanians Say He Was Shot, But Britain Hears a Different Story

LONDON, Sept. 23.—The German wireless Press Bureau told London last night that Jules Vedrines, the French aviator, had been tried for high treason and shot. On the heels of this cry of "Wolf" from Berlin, England learned that Vedrines was the hero of a desperate aerial fight in which, after chasing and averhauling a Taube which had attacked a food convoy, he gave battle at an altitude of six thousand feet. Opening fire, he destroyed the Taube which crashed to the earth, killing the German pilot and his assistant. This is the second Taube which Vedrines has destroyed, within three days.

### U. S. WAR TAX BILL INTRODUCED TO-DAY

Provides Measure for Securing \$105,000,000 in Revenue to Supplement Customs

WASHINGTON, Sept. 23.—Majority Leader Underwood introduced in the House of Representatives today the Administration's emergency "war tax" bill, designed to produce approximately \$105,000,000 in revenue to offset the losses in customs receipts during the European war. The bill, the details of which were announced Saturday night, will be reported by the Ways and Means Committee tomorrow and taken up in the House Thursday.

Dr. Fritjof Nansen Warns Norway that Her Situation is Precarious

CHRISTIANIA, September 23.—Dr. Fritjof Nansen, former Norwegian Minister to Great Britain, caused a sensation on Saturday night in this quiet and punctiliously neutral capital when he stated before an assembly composed of prominent members of the Cabinet and students of Christiania University that Norway's situation is as precarious as that of Belgium.

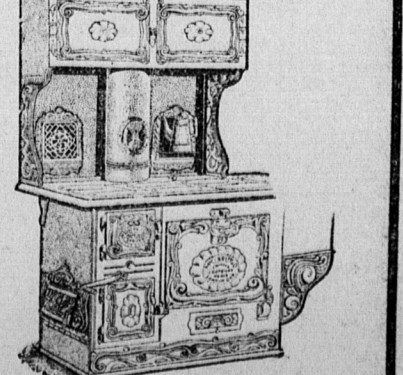
