City Councillors will do well to listen to what the people are saying in regard to the city lighting.

Should it turn out as Hon. Mr. Sifton stated to the electors of Brandon that there will be no election for the House of Commons till after another session, the fact will be disappointing to the Provincial Government here, who will have to go to the country before that time.

Of course before taking action in regard to the lighting contract the City Council will have before it a full report from the Light Committee, with the information as to how many meetings that committee has held since its appointment and a general account of its arduous labors, voluminous correspondence and the facts gathered from other cities.

Premier Peters is on his way homeward and is expected to arrive during the coming week. So far as the representation case is concerned he has failed in his mission, but from no fault of his own or of his Government. The Judicial Committee like the Supreme Court of Canada were firmly convinced that we had no case. It is an awkward thing for the Government that a provincial election will of necessity follow pretty closely on the hanging of our hopes, but the situation must be faced.

All races will be rowed in best and best shells, and canoe races paddled in best and best canoes.
