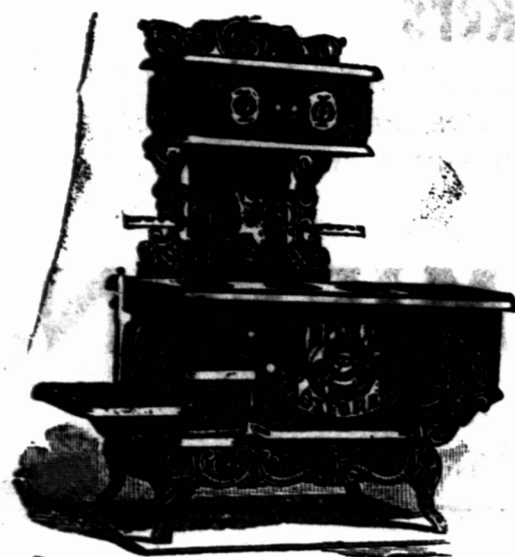

**THE EXHIBITION.**

The Exhibition will be open to visitors  
today at 10 o'clock and the formal opening  
by His Honor, Lieutenant Governor  
McIntyre, will take place at 3 o'clock  
this afternoon, when addresses will be  
given by a number of prominent persons.  
The competition will be an interprovincial  
one, and as the fall fairs of the other  
Maritime Provinces are over we may expect  
many exhibitors and visitors from  
New Brunswick and Nova Scotia as well  
as from the Western Provinces of Canada.

This has been so far the greatest year  
for successful exhibitions that Canada  
has yet seen, the attendance at one and  
all of these agricultural and industrial  
fairs being much larger than in past years.  
This shows that farmers, stockmen, and  
manufacturers are now more than heretofore  
appreciating the good effect of  
exhibitions from both an educational  
and an advertising point of view. It has  
been now two years since the last exhibition  
in the Island, and both exhibitors  
and visitors will come to the present  
show with the greater zest and interest  
on that account.

That the fair which opens to-day  
in Charlottetown will be largely  
patronised is assured by the large number  
of entries already made, by the number of  
interested enquiries from abroad and by  
the fact that over six thousand dollars are  
offered in prizes. There are in addition  
to the ordinary features of an agricultural  
and industrial Exhibition special features  
of rare interest which cannot fail to  
attract the patronage of young and old.  
Being limited to four days, intending  
visitors should improve the earliest opportunity  
of looking in upon the fair lest  
unfavorable weather may prevent a later  
visitor.

Two days are set apart for the races,  
Wednesday and Thursday, on which days  
especially large attendance may be expected  
from the fine field of horses that  
are to contest for first place. Visitors will  
remember that the opportunity to see the  
splendid display of the fruits of the field  
and manufactured wares—the greatest  
display ever made in Prince Edward Island—  
will be limited to four days and  
three evenings, as the Exhibition will be  
closed to the Public on Friday afternoon  
at 6 o'clock.

A Cape Town despatch tells that a return  
submitted to the Cape Colony Legislature  
shows that 3,347 rebels who surrendered  
under the peace proclamation have been  
disfranchised for life.

The London Daily Mail makes the astonishing  
statement that the South African Colonies  
will be required to pay \$500,000,000 toward  
the cost of the Boer war, that they will be  
allowed ample time in which to make the  
payment, is added. But even to pay the  
interest on this vast sum at the rate of  
three per cent would apparently greatly  
overtax their present resources. At that  
rate the interest charge, without reducing  
the principal would be \$15,000,000 yearly.

We are surprised to find the usually  
tolerant and well-conducted Presbyterian  
Witness speaking of "the Baptist sects,"  
in its latest issue. Presumably it was  
only a slip of the pen, but the esteemed  
Witness would hardly like to find in the  
denominational organ of another Christian  
body the phrase "the Presbyterian sect."  
The word "sect" has been so frequently  
used in an opprobrious sense that its  
application in the way the Witness uses it  
gives offence to many persons.

The Tarte question is fast becoming the  
principal political question in Canada. For  
a good while the leading Liberal papers  
remained silent in face of the erratic  
deliverances of the Minister of Public  
Works. Then they made a combined  
effort to silence him, but he refused to be  
silenced. In fact he grew "tarter." One  
can only imagine what will take place  
when he meets his colleagues in the  
Cabinet again, and especially when he  
meets his party in Parliament. If there  
is an office in Canada fat enough for Mr.  
Tarte to be induced to accept, and of  
potency sufficient to compel his silence,  
his leader and colleagues had better lose  
no time in appointing him thereto. He  
has already furnished the Opposition with  
many rounds of very effective ammunition.
